The Marshall Music Fund is for Educators in the Marshall Public Schools seeking to enhance Music Programs for 5th through 12th grade. All music fields, including instrumental and vocal, are eligible to apply. Funding supports programming up to one year.

Application Process:

Along with the application form that is attached the following is needed: two recommendation letters, one from the Superintendent and one from an adult member in the community. There is room provided on the application form, however feel free to attach additional pages.

Grants will be awarded to educators whose job description under the Marshall Public Schools master contract is teacher, special teacher or counselor. Grants awarded to educators will vary with the program relative to the educators' proposals, the funds available for distribution (maximum of \$500.00 per recipient) and at the discretion of the Marshall Community Foundation's Board of Trustees. The funds awarded will be directed to the Marshall Public Schools.
