The Phillip R. Clissold Vocal Music scholarship provides awards to Marshall Public School choir students (Grade 7-11) wishing to attend a Summer Vocal Music Camp/Seminar. Recipients are required to continue in the vocal music program in good standing for 12 months after being awarded. Western Michigan University or Wolverine Camps are preferred but others will be considered.

- Monetary award will be directed to the recipient's chosen educational institution on his/her behalf.
