

Peter C. Stuart Journalism Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship awarded to a High School graduating senior, previous graduate or previous recipient who will be pursuing a career in journalism or a clearly related curriculum at a 4- year institution. Qualifying applicants must maintain passing grades for the year of the scholarship.*

Essay Question: Prepare a short essay on the impact of the electronic media upon the written media and how the principle of truthful and accurate reporting can be maintained. (The significant change in publication of the Monitor from all print to a combination of print and electronic media is a good example of the change which has taken place.)

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a high school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, please obtain and complete Marshall Community Foundation financial aid information form and return with scholarship application*
