

Nicole Marie Burmeister Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship to be awarded to a Marshall High School graduating senior who has experienced a major life event or challenge and has overcome it or is persevering to overcome it. Qualifying applicants should exhibit Nicole's personal traits of persistence, a willingness to help others, a willingness to try, and a love of the outdoors and life. Applicants must plan on attending a two or four year institution as a full time student. GPA is not a qualifying factor.*

Essay Question: What major life challenge have you experienced and how did it or does it effect you as the person you are now?

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a high school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: Not required

Application Process: Return completed application, including recommendation letter(s), essay question(s), and any other qualifying criteria to: Marshall Community Foundation, 126 West Michigan Avenue, Suite 202, Marshall, MI 49068.
