

Coury and Kesselring Natural Resources Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship to be awarded to a Calhoun County graduating senior or previous Coury and Kesselring Natural Resources Scholarship recipient seeking to further their education in Natural Resources or a related field at any Michigan College or University. Qualify applicants may begin education at a 2 year institution with plans to complete at a 4 institution. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required.*

Essay Questions: 1) Why have you chosen to go into the natural resources field? 2) Tell about experience or community service pertaining to natural resources (Agriculture experience, classes, FFA, 4-H, etc.)

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from high school administrator/educator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: Not required

Application Process: Return completed application, including recommendation letter(s), essay question(s), and any other qualifying criteria to: Marshall Community Foundation, 126 West Michigan Avenue, Suite 202, Marshall, MI 49068.
