

Dick and Anita Drake Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *Two scholarships to be awarded, one to a Marshall High School graduating senior and one to an Albion High School graduating senior who has chosen to attend a community college as a full time student. Qualifying applicants must demonstrate financial need and have verification by employer that student will be working at least 15 hours a week while attending school. Plans to complete a degree at a 4- year college may be a determining factor. A minimum GPA of 2.0 is required.*

Essay Questions: 1) What field have you chosen to continue your studies? 2) What based your decision to attend a community college for reaching your goals? 3) How will your part-time work impact or benefit your goal to attaining a college degree?

Recommendation Letters: One required from current employer.

Financial Criteria: *Yes, please obtain and complete Marshall Community Foundation financial aid information form and return with scholarship application*
