

Dube and Katie Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *Scholarship(s) to be awarded to Marshall High School graduating seniors who have experienced a major life loss or challenge and have overcome it or are persevering to overcome it. Qualifying applicants must be pursuing a college, technical, or trade school degree and demonstrate a financial need. A minimum GPA of 2.0 is required.*

Essay Question: What major life loss or challenges have you experienced and how have you overcome the obstacles?

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from high school administrator/educator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, please obtain and complete Marshall Community Foundation financial aid information form and return with scholarship application*

Application Process: Return completed application, including recommendation letter(s), essay question(s), and any other qualifying criteria to: Marshall Community Foundation, 126 West Michigan Avenue, Suite 202, Marshall, MI 49068.
