

Milt and Irene Jenks Memorial Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: A scholarship awarded in **EVEN** numbered years to a Marshall High School graduating senior who will be pursuing a career in Criminal Justice or Law Enforcement at a 2 or 4 year institution and in **ODD** numbered years to a Marshall High School graduating senior who will be pursuing a LPN or RN at a 2 or 4 year institution. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required.

Essay Question: 1) Please explain in 250 words or less why you want to pursue a career in Law Enforcement. 2) In addition to the first essay question, choose 2 of the following to respond to: a) Choose one of your most meaningful experiences and describe how it relates to law enforcement and your goals for the future, b) Choose a person or persons you admire and explain why, c) Describe how you have demonstrated leadership in your school and community, or d) What special qualities do you think a person in a Law Enforcement career should have?

Recommendation Letters: One required from a high school educator/administrator.

Financial Criteria: Not required
