

Jeff Kittinger Memorial Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship to be awarded to a Marshall High School graduating senior pursuing higher education in engineering. Qualifying applicants need a strong academic standing, engineering focus, out-going personality, and exemplary citizenship. Preference may be given to automotive interest, part-time employment during high school, and acceptance to a major Michigan college or university. GPA is not a qualifying factor, but transcripts and scores are required.*

Essay Questions: 1) Describe how you arrived at your interest in engineering and what your career goals are in this field. 2) What activities have you been involved with that enhanced your interest in engineering?

Recommendation Letters: One required from a high school educator/administrator.

Financial Criteria: Not required
