

K. John Lord Engineering and Science Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *Scholarship(s) to be awarded to Marshall High School graduating seniors, former graduates, or previous K. John Lord Engineering and Science Scholarship recipients pursuing the field of Engineering or the Sciences. Applicants must plan on attending a two or four year institution of their choice as a full-time student. Preference may be given to qualifying applicants demonstrating financial need. GPA is not a qualifying factor.*

Essay Questions: Why are you pursuing a career in engineering and/or science and what do you hope to achieve by obtaining a degree in your chosen field?

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from high school educator/administrator, and one from adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, please obtain and complete Marshall Community Foundation financial aid information form and return with scholarship application*
