

Marilyn Paskett Memorial Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship to be awarded to a Marshall High School graduating senior planning on attending any two-year, four-year, or technical school on a part-time or full-time basis while pursuing the field of education. Qualifying applicants must provide a list of community and school activities and a job history. Financial information is required, but not necessarily a determining factor. A minimum GPA of 2.0 is required.*

Essay Questions: Why do you feel it is important to be involved in extra curricular activities and how has it impacted your life?

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a high school educator/administrator and one from an employer or an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, please obtain and complete Marshall Community Foundation financial aid information form and return with scholarship application*
