

Herold and Retta Reuss Public Safety Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *Scholarship(s) to be awarded to Marshall Area residents or previous Herold and Retta Reuss Public Safety Scholarship recipients who are pursuing a career in the Criminal Justice, Emergency Medical Services, or other related fields, such as but not limited to, Fireman, Policeman, Legal Secretary or Dispatcher. Qualifying applicants must demonstrate the drive and ability to be successful in pursuing a college education and/or a certification process in the fields aforementioned. Financial need may be a deciding factor. Minimum GPA not required.*

Essay Questions: What field have you chosen to pursue in your studies? What made you decide to pursue this career? How do you hope to impact the community around you?

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from high school educator/administrator or employer and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, please obtain and complete Marshall Community Foundation financial aid information form and return with scholarship application*
