Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *Scholarship(s) to be awarded to graduating seniors from Barry, Branch, Calhoun, and Eaton Counties or previous UAW Scholarship recipients who plan to attend a trade school, community college and/or a four year institution. Qualifying applicants must demonstrate financial need, leadership skills, involvement in the community and extra curricular activities. Preference may be given to applicants related to UAW members and or retirees. GPA is not a qualifying factor, but transcripts and scores are requested.*

Essay Question: Why have you chosen to go into your particular field of study? What goals and objectives have you set for yourself regarding college study and pursuit of a career? ***Please provide any relation(s) to UAW members or retirees.***

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a high school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community, preferable an employer (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, please obtain and complete the Marshall Community Foundation Financial Aid Information Form and return with scholarship application.*
