

Beatrice Williams Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship of approximately \$300.00 to be awarded to a Marshall High School graduating senior who is pursuing Elementary Education as a career goal. Qualifying applicants must plan to attend a higher education institute full time. GPA is not a qualifying factor.*

Essay Questions: 1) Why have you chosen a career in education as your goal? Include information regarding your experience working with children. Childcare, playground supervision and assisting in an elementary classroom as a volunteer are experiences to draw upon.

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a high school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: Not required

Application Process: Return completed application, including recommendation letter(s), essay question(s), and any other qualifying criteria to: Marshall Community Foundation, 126 West Michigan Avenue, Suite 202, Marshall, MI 49068.
